 Sound Merchantable leaf Tobacco in Cash of y^e value
 of twenty three pounds three Shillings & Six pence Sterling
 money to be paid to the same p^{er} when thereto required yet
 the a^{bove} Debt altho often required the a^{bove} four pounds two
 Shillings & ten pence Sterling money and the a^{bove} five Thou-
 sand five hundred Sixty two pounds of Tobacco to the said p^{er}
 hath not rendered but the same to render y^e said Debt hath
 hath denied and yet doth deny and the a^{bove} Tobacco unjustly
 detain to the damage of the said p^{er} forty pounds
 Sterling money and thereupon he bringe suite &
