AND the aff pleat by his atty saith that he by any thing by the aff Deft above in pleading alledgeed free having and maintaining his own aff to be barred ought not because he saith that the said Deft upon the aff twentieth day of Novemb. did not pay the said sume of two pound one shilling & five pence and the said two thousand seven hundred & eighty one pound of Tobacco in the condition above mentioned and this he prays may be inquired of by the Country etc.
