William Smithers and his Recognizance taken in the Summe of ten pounds Sterling for his appearance to this Court last and Good Behaviour in the meantime the Same Court Continued the Same Recognizance to this Present Court And now at this Court the Same Court Discharges the Same Recognizance

Like wise at the Same time William Booth and George Murphree each Entered into Recognizance in the Summe of two pounds Sterling each for the appearance and Good Behaviour of the said William Smithers as above The Same being Continued as above This Court here discharges the Said Recognizances each of them

And now at this Court the Bill of Indenture is as follows by Kent County Maryland The Jurors for our Sovereign Lord the King that now is the body of Kent County upon their Oath do present that William Smithers of Morgantown Creek upper imbed in the County aforesaid on the tenth day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and four teen at said place upper imbed in the County aforesaid within the Jurisdiction of this Court by force & Arms
