Crown & Dignity & against the forme of an Act of Assembly of this
Province now in force in such Case made & provided Johnson of Indigo

John Johnson Clarke of the Indulments for this County Court
comes into Court and by Consent of the Court orders that the same
Indulment be no farther prosecuted there being no sufficient Evidence
to maintain the same. Ordered by the Court here that the same
be entered. Therefore it is considered by the Court here
on this twenty fourth day of March Anno Domini one Thou:
sand Seven hundred and fifteen That the aforesaid Mary Neale as
to the aforesaid Indulment be therefrom acquitted and that she go
thereof without day paying the fees accruing to the officers of
this Court on the premises aforesaid amounting to the sum of Eleven
hundred Seventy four pounds of Tobacco
