of the next Court to be hold at our Court house in the Town of Chest. in said County to
Answer unto Bartholomew Brown of a plea of Trespass upon y^e Case and that he
have then and there the said writ c. All which said next Court by the second day
of March of same Year last mentioned the day of return of said writ came James
Harris Gent High Sheriff of said County and made return thereof in these words
thorow Endorsed as foll. viz. Capi Corpus per J^{us} Harris Sh.

And a Declaration being filed when said writ issued forth and a Copy thereof
served therow. According to Act of Assembly in such Case made was to be fill by
Maryland Kent County's Daniel Cely late of Kent County and planter Slave.

& performed in his the said p^{ty} and practised divers visits to divers of y^e said
Doct^r Family while they languished under divers grievous Malady & indisposing
to restore them to languishing to health did divers good Services in his said
Practice all for y^e proper use and behoofe of y^e said Doct^r which said Medicines
& Physical preparations said visits & Services specifically appear in an Account
commencing y^e second day of March Anno Seventeen hundred & eleven &
ending y^e fifth day of July. Amounts Amounted in Consideration whereof
his y^e said Doct^r on y^e fifth day of July Anno Domini Seventeen hundred
and twelve and at the Parish in the County & Jurisdiction of upon himselfe
assured
