Francis Cooke one of the attorneys of this Court comes into Court and prays that John Coane of said County may be bound to his good behaviour for that he the said John Coane is endeavour to do me the said Francis some bodily hurt to which he pray his oath may be tendered and the said Francis Cooke takes his Corporall oath on the Holy Evangelists of Almighty God and saith that he stands in fear of the said John Coane and that he believes the said John will do him some bodily hurt and that he doth the same without any private Malice or grudging but of very fear and for needfull safety of his body and pray that he may continue in peace on account of the same. The said John Coane being called came and in his proper person appeared to the same and is ordered to give Surety to enter into recognizance for his appearance at next Court and good behaviour in of mean time

John Coane of comes into Court and acknowledgeth himself indebted to her Majesty's Queen Anne her Heirs & Successors in the full and just sum of Forty Shillings Sterling to be levied on his goods and Chattels Lands and Tenements Conditionally that if he do not make his personall appearance at the next Court and then and there to answer unto all such things as shall be objected against him on behalfe of her Majesty and that in the mean time he is to be of good behaviour to all her Majesty's good people and especially to the said Francis Cooke. The said John Coane acknowledgeth himselfe thereunto to be content.

Likewise M^r. Daniel Pearce and Doctor John March both of this County here in Court cometh and do acknowledge themselves indebted to her Majesty's Queen Anne her Heirs and Successors in the full and just sum of Twenty Shillings Sterling each to be levied on their goods and Chattels Lands and Tenements Conditionally that if the said John Coane do not make his personall appearance at the next Court and to answer as above and that in the mean time he is to be of good behaviour to all her Majesty's good people and especially to Francis Cooke above mentioned wherewith they acknowledge themselves thereto to be content.
