Court a Certificate Concerning the age of an Negro Girl belonging to himself to be adjudged when she will be at Age According to the same therefore it is considered by the Court here viz. this fourth Day of June Annoque Domini one Thousand Seven hundred and fourteen That the said Negro Girl by Certificate is Twelve years of Age next September

A Rule of Court as followeth viz. That if any person or persons be brought before this Court as an Evidence in the Majesty's Behalfes either by Warrant or otherwise to give Evidence to the Grand Jury against any person or persons and shall be found that such persons as Evidence shall be allowed from of persons Escaped thirty pounds of Tobacco per Day for every day they shall attend this Court not exceeding three days

And to answer unto all such things as should be objected against him on his Majesty's Behalfes viz. The Court here Discharges the said Recognizance

Likewise Richard Davis and John Wandrichsen each entered into Recognizance in the Sum of Ten pounds Sterling each viz. for the appearance of the said Samuel Coll at this Court viz. To answer as of the said Recognizances each of them are by this Court here Discharged.

And the same Recognizances being since last Court moved by a Citorari. But since a Provedendo was sent from the Provincial Court bearing date the twenty fourth Day of April last signed by Beale to be granted in the said Recognizances and process against the said Samuel Coll as if the same had not been moved by Citorari
