Complaining well Comend you that you Attach any the Goods Chattells Rights or Credits of Robert Dunchley
Esq. of Kent County Kt. If they shall be found in your Bayliwick to of value of some pounds English
Shillings Sterling money of Great Brittain and Ireland hundred pounds of Tobacco or when you
have of same so attached or any part thereof the same in your Custody keep so that you have
them before of Justices of our said County Court to be hold at our Court house in the Town of
Chapton in said County on the first Tuesday in August next then & there to be Condemned according
to Act of Assembly & to the use of a Certain Margret Smith unless he the said Robert Dunchley
Esq. by his self or his attorney shall appear and Answer unto of said Margret Smith in a plea
of Trespass upon the Case according to Law and that by good & Lawfull men of your Bayliwick
you make known unto the Person or persons in whose hands you make of said Attachment
that he she or they be and appear before of Justices of our said Court to be hold as aforesaid
unless if any he she or they have why of same Goods Chattells rights or Credits so attached
in his her or their hands ought not to be Condemned according to Law if he she or they do
shall soon most and how you shall Execute this writt that you make known unto our Justices
at the day & place aforesaid and have you then and there this writt witness William Soree
Esq. Chief Justice of our said Court this fourth day of August the thirtenth Year of our
Reigne &c. Anno Domini 1714 Borne & given at Westminster the 4th

And now at this Court came the said Pet. and prayd Condemnation of the above
mentioned fifteen hundred thirty two pounds of Tobacco in of return of the above
Attachment in the hands of the above mentioned Peter Green as Garnishe of the of
Debt. as being the Rights and Credits of of said Debt Robert Dunchley and the
said Peter Green being called came not nor any person for him to shew Cause why
the said Tobacco should not be Condemned for the use of me of Pet. by which
