 Abjuration and the Customed Oath of Under Sheriff.

James Smith also comes into Court and takes the Oath of Allegiance and Supremacy as  
 also the Oath of Abjuration and the Customed Oath of Clerk of this Court.

Mr. Thomas Borne also comes into Court and takes the Oath of Allegiance and  
 Supremacy as also the Oath of Abjuration and the Customed Oath of Attorney.

Mr. John Johnson also comes into Court and takes the aforesaid Oaths as also the Oath  
 of Attorney. And produces to this Court a Commission from William Bladen Esquire  
 his Majesty's Attorney General to be Clerk of the Judgments of this Court the same  
 Commission bears date the thirtieth day of October last in the first year of the reign  
 of our Sovereign Lord George King etc. and the same being read the same is ordered to  
 be sworn accordingly the same John Johnson is sworn as Clerk of the Judgments to the same  
 Commission and is thereupon admitted.

 as also the Oath of Abjuration and the Customed Oath of Attorney.

Mr. George Worsley also comes into Court and takes the Oath of Allegiance and Supremacy as
