George Sanders appointed Constable of upper South Sappaphus hundred in the

Room of Thomas Pryor. The said George comes into Court and is Sworn as a J. P.

James Davis appointed Constable of Chester hundred in the Room of Mr. Thomas.

Foreman The said James comes into Court and is Sworn as a J. P.

M^r William Comegys being one of the Justices mentioned in the above Dedimus is called to take the Oath of office and the Oath of Abjuration as by the same Dedimus is directed comes into Court and this Court desires him to take y^e same Oaths &c. which he says that he at present will not take the said Oaths he being at present not satisfied as to the Oath of Abjuration.

Daniel Malloye comes into Court and takes his Corporall Oath on the Holy Evangelists of Almighty God and swears that his Account is just and true as it stands stated against Patrick Burke for the Sum of Eighteen hundred pounds of Tobacco and that he hath received no part thereof.

Court adjourns to morrow morning eight Clock.

A Lett^r from the Clarke of the Council read as follows
City of Annapolis June 28. 1714

Worshipfull Gent. I am Commanded by his Excellency in Council to acquaint you that he requests you forthwith to certify unto him what Causes are depending before you and also that you give him some Reasonable Answer why the said Causes are not Determined His Excellency in Council is likewise pleased to Order as it is hereby ordered that the Clarke of your County Court yearly Transmitt to him a Dockett of all the Causes in that your Court brought you and the Reasons of your severall Continuances and adjournments.
