Therefore it is Considered by the Court here on this fourth day of November Annoque Domini one Thousand seven hundred and fourteen That the said Patrick Manderfon at the Expiration of his Service above mentioned forso his said Master William Jones the Sum of Six Months for the said Tobacco.
