Shant County greeting well Command you that you attach any the Goods Chattells Rights or Credits of John Budd of the said County planter and D^r John Budd planter of Kent County if they shall be found in your Baywicks to y^e Value of Twelve hundred and Twenty five pounds of Tobacco & when y^e have the Same So Attached or any part thereof the Same in your Custody keepe so that you have the Same before the Justice of our next County Court to be held at our Court house in the Town of Chester in Said County on the first Tuesday in November next next and there to be Examined according to Act of Assembly to and for y^e use of a Certain Thomas Christian unless the said John Budd by himselfe or his attorney shall appear and Answer unto y^e said Thomas Christian in a plea that he render unto him the full and Just Summe of one Thousand two hundred pounds of good Sound Merchantable Long Tobacco which from him he unjustly detains according to Law & that by good and Lawfull men of your Baywicks you make known unto y^e Person or Persons in whose hands you make y^e Same that he she or they be and app^r before the Justice of our said Court to be hold in case to shew cause if any he she or they have why the same Goods Chattells Rights or Credits So Attached in his her or there hands ought not to be Condemned according to Law if to him her or them it shall seem meet & how you shall Execute this writ that you make known unto our said Justice at the day & place afo^r said have you then & there this writ Witness William Poore Gent Justice of our Court this 3^d day of August in the 13th year of King George the 5th Annoque domini 1714

By Virtue of y^e within writ to me Directed by Justice within mentioned I have that I have attached of the goods and Chattells of y^e within named John Budd to y^e Value of Twelve hundred forty and four pounds of Tobacco to Satisfie unto y^e within named Thomas Christian part y^e within mentioned Debt and Cost that is to say a parcel of Tobacco hanging in y^e possession of a Certain James Boyer Computed to be the Quantity of Six hundred as also w^old Gum value one hundred and fifty pounds of Tobacco in the hands of Robert Jones also one Iron pot value one hundred and forty pounds of Tobacco also one add one Drawing knife one hand Saw value fifty two pounds of Tobacco also one bare Sifter value twelve pounds of Tobacco also a parcel of old feathers value Ninety pounds of Tobacco also one Blankett value forty pounds of Tobacco also ten w^old Spoons value Twenty four pounds of Tobacco also three Smalls
