 value thirty pounds of Tobacco amounting in the whole to value hundred forty and four  
 pounds of Tobacco and have made known to the above named James Boyer Robert  
 Jones and William Sinson that they be and appear at the time and place within mentioned  
 to show cause if any they have why the said goods and Chattells should not be condemned  
 in their hands before George Murphy and Hapton Williams good and Lawfull men of  
 my Baywick as of within West Quarter and Nequeroth &c. To W<sup>m</sup> Frisby Sher.

AND NOW at the same Court by this fourth day of Novemb<sup>r</sup>. the same year last  
 mentioned came the said Pet<sup>r</sup>. by Thomas Barrow his atty and pray Condemnation of the  
 above mentioned Goods and Chattells and Credits as the Rights of the said Deft.  
 Attached in the hands of James Boyer Robert Jones and William Sinson. The said  
 James Boyer Robert Jones and William Sinson being solemnly called to show Cause if any  
 they or any of them had why what was attached in there or any of there hands  
 should not be condemned to the use of the said Pet<sup>r</sup>. But the said James Boyer  
 Robert Jones and William Sinson not appearing to the said Attachment nor the  
 return on the same nor any person in there or any of there Co-habers doth  
 not appear to show cause why the said Goods Chattells & Credits attached in  
 there hands as afo<sup>r</sup> should not be condemned according to Law for the use of  
 the said Pet<sup>r</sup>. . . Therefore it is Considered by the Court here by  
 the same day last mentioned that the said sum of Six hundred pounds of Tobacco in the  
 hands of James Boyer (as the Right of the said John Budd) be condemned to the use of the  
 said Pet<sup>r</sup> and that the said Thomas Christian have thereof Execution &c. Also that  
 the said Goods and Chattells in the hands of a Certain Robert Jones (as the Goods & Chattells  
 of the said John Budd) to the value of Six hundred and fourteen pounds of Tobacco  
 be condemned to the use of the said Pet<sup>r</sup>. and that the said Thomas Christian have  
 thereof Execution &c. Also the said three Iron Wedges as the Goods and Chattells of the  
 said Deft in the hands of a Certain William Sinson to the value of thirty pounds of  
 Tobacco be condemned to the use of the said Pet<sup>r</sup>. and that the said Thomas Christian have  
 thereof Execution &c. and that the said Pet<sup>r</sup> give Surety as in such Case is usual. Jan<sup>y</sup> 1715
