

for all payes value sixty pounds of Tobacco also one Dinger one Chissell value Twenty five pounds of Tobacco also eight pounds of old Iron value Eight pounds of Tobacco also one old Barrell value thirty pounds of Tobacco attacted in the hands and possession of a certain Robert Jones also three Iron Wedges in hands and possession of William Sinifer value thirty pounds of Tobacco amounting in whole to two hundred fourty and four pounds of Tobacco and have made knowne to y^e above named James Boyer Robert Jones and William Sinifer that they be and appear at y^e time and place within mentioned to shew cause if any they have why the said goods and Chattells shoule not be condemned in these hands before George Marphoy and Hughe Williams good and Lawfull men of my Baylye as of within Whist Sancteth and Agneth v. W^r Trisby Thos.

And 11010 at the same Court day this fourth day of November the same year last mentioned came the said p^r by Thomas Bowens his atty and pray Condemnation of the said goods mentioned Goods and Chattells and Cadets as the Rightts of the afof Doff attacted in the hands of James Boyer Robert Jones and William Sinifer All said James Boyer Robert Jones and Williamson being solemnly called to shew cause why they or any of them had why what was attacted in these or any of these hands shoule not be condemned to the use of the afof p^r. But the said James Boyer Robert Jones and William Sinifer not appearing to the afof attacement nor the returne on the same Nor any person in these or any of these behalves doth not appear to shew why the afof Goods Chattells & Cadets attacted in these hands as afof shoule not be condemned according to law for the use of the said p^r. Therefore it is considered by the Court here by the same day last mentioned that y^e sum of Six hundred pounds of Tobacco in the hands of Jas^r Boyer (as the Right of the afof John Budd) be condemned to y^e use of the said p^r and that the said Thomas Christian have bearinge v. d^r also that the afof Goods and Chattells in the hands of a certain Robert Jones (as the Goods & Chattells of the afof John Budd) to the value of One hundred and fourty pounds of Tobacco be condemned to the use of y^e afof p^r. and that the said Thomas Christian have bearinge v. d^r also the afof three Iron Wedges as the Goods and Chattells of the said Doff in the hands of a certain William Sinifer to y^e value of thirty pounds of Tobacco be condemned to the use of the afof p^r. and that the said Thomas Christian have bearinge v. d^r and that y^e afof p^r give security as in last Court of fall. Whereupon came into Court Charles Hyson of this County and Escompt^r Securit^r for the afof Thomas Christian that if the said Doff shall within a year and day from a word
