Anne c. That he take George Hill late of Kent County Ship Carpenter
if he should be found in this County & him safe keep so that he
have his Body before the said Majesties Justice of the Peace Court to be hold for said County at
the Court house in the Town of Rochester to answer unto Edward Scott of the said County March
of a plea of Trespass upon the Case and that he have then & there the said writ est.

At which said next Court on the second day of November in the same year
last mentioned the day of return of said writ came William Trisby Grand High Sheriff of the
County and made return thereof in these words thereto endorsed as followeth viz
Capi Copio W^m Trisby Sheriff... and now at this Court came the said W^m Trisby
Bourne his attorney and declared as followeth viz Maryland Kent County of George Hill late
of Kent County Ship Carpenter stands attached to answer unto Edward Scott of the said County
March of a plea of Trespass upon the Case

AND wherupon the said Edward
Scott his attorney complains that whereas the said George the fifth day of May in the
year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred & fourteen at the parish of St. Paul in the County
and within the Jurisdiction of this Court in Consideration that the said Edward at the Special
Instance & request of the said George then & there had paid & satisfied unto a certain Board
of eight hundred pounds of Tobacco as by an Acc^t hereto annexed appears did assume upon
himself to be the said Edward Scott then & there faithfully promised that he the said George
the said sum a quantity of eight hundred pounds of Tobacco (as aforesaid) to the said Edward
Scott when ever he should be thereto required would well & truly content & pay yet
Nevertheless the said George his promise & Assumption in form aforesaid made not regarding but
endeavouring & fraudulently intending him the said Edward Scott in this part craftily &
subtly to Deceive & Defraud the said eight hundred pounds of Tobacco nor any part
thereof to the said Edward Scott hath not paid Altho' to do the same the said Edward Scott
afterwards (to wit) the seventh day of May at the parish aforesaid in the County & Jurisdiction
aforesaid by the said Edward Scott hath been thereto required but to him he refused to pay said
altogether gainsayed & he that gainsays wherupon he says he is of worse & better
damages
