and this Court doth award that the said W<sup>m</sup> William Sott be as guardian  
to the said James Gallaway the said Indenture acknowledged in Court

James Duerly Son to William Duerly Esq of said County dec. of  
now about ten years old is by this Court and his Consent bound by  
Indenture to William Woodland of this County Carpenter to learn the trade of  
Carpenter and also to read writ and Cypher and that he may read well in the  
English a faire legible hand and Cypher as far as Dierpson and to be proficied  
in all his rules to Dierpson and Dierpson proficied when at the age of  
twenty one years the said Indenture acknowledged in Court

Susannah Gallaway daughter of James Gallaway Esq of the said County  
dec. the said daughter being now about ten years old is by this Court and her  
Consent bound by Indenture to Roger Hailer of this County to learn her house work  
also to sett say and spin and to learn her to read in the bible so that she  
may do the same when at the age of her teen years or day of Marriage  
which shall first happen according to Law
