Such Surors as the same Justice should think fit for her personal appearance before of Justice of the then next Court to be hold at the Court house in the Town of Chester in said County to answer unto a Certain Bill of Judgment found against her for Committing fornication w. a Certain man unknown &c. And that he was to have then and there the said process &c. All which said next Court viz. the first day of March in the Year last mentioned came the Constable of the Hundred East mentioned and returned his receipt as followeth These are to Certifie to the Justice within mentioned that I have taken the within Elizabeth as by the receipt I am Commanded by Benj Griffith Constable in which came Mr. William Pitt. one of his Majesty's Justice of our said Lord the King and made return of a Recognizance taken before him for the appearance of the said Elizabeth Weeks. And the said Elizabeth being called came and in her proper person appeared to the said Recognizance and prayd that she might be Discharged from the same. Ordered by the Court here that the said Elizabeth Weeks be discharged from the said Recognizance and also in her Surors from these Recognizances for her appearance Elizabeth Weeks and entered into Recognizance before the said Pitt. the twelfth day of July last in the sum of Twenty pounds said money &c. to be paid to his Majesty his honor and Successors &c. if in Case she the said Elizabeth did not make her personal appearance before the Justice of this Court in Court sitting and also that she was to answer unto a Certain Bill of Judgment found against her for Committing fornication &c. This Court here discharged the same Recognizance.

Likewise James Weeks and Francis Rand at the same time last mentioned entered into Recognizance to his Majesty &c. in the sum of ten pounds said each to be paid &c. if in Case the above Elizabeth did not make her personal appearance at this present Court and to answer &c. This Court here discharged the same Recognizances each of them &c.

And the Judgment against the said Elizabeth for Assault viz. Kent County in Maryland &c. The Jurors for our Sovereign Lady of Queen that now is for the County of Kent County and upon their Oath do present that Elizabeth Weeks daughter of James and Elizabeth Weeks of South Passapatan Hundred in Kent County and Spouster the year of God not having the thirtieth day of July Anno Domini Seventeen hundred and Twelve and at divers other times in the same Year at South Passapatan Hundred in Kent County and
