This Court here discharges the same Prognuance.

The Grand Jury having presented the app. John for Committing Fornication with a Certain Elizabeth Poulson whose present. was by John Johnson Clarke of the Judgments framed into a Bill w. followeth viz. Kent - County Maryland vs The Jurors for our Sovereign Lord the King that now is and the body of Kent County that now is upon their Oath do -

Present that John Underhill Jun^r. of Worton Hundred in the County of Solours the first day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand Seven hundred and twenty at Worton Hundred aforesaid in the County of ... within the Jurisdiction of this Court the fear of God before his eyes not having but by the Justification of the Deed did commit Fornication with a Certain Elizabeth Poulson and did thereby begett a base Child on the body of the said Elizabeth to the high Displeasure of Almighty God against the peace of our Sovereign Lord the King that now is his Crown and Dignity and against the forme of
