take John Radish late of sd County Gent if he should
be found in his Baywick and him safe keep so that he have his body before
his sayd Majesties Justices of the next Court to be held at the Court house in
the Town of Rochester in said County to answer unto John Green of a plea of
Trespasse upon the Case and that he have ther and thores the said writ &c

All which said next Court viz the first day of March in the year of the
day of Return of said writ Came William Freby Gent High Sheriff of said County
and made returns therof in these words Theron Indorsed as followeth viz
Capi Coram Wm Freby Sheriff. AND the said Deft. being Called Came
and the said pte by Thomas Barone his attorney prays that the said
Deft may give Speciall Bayle to the above Owen which is Granted
After which Comes into Court John Crow of this County and doth acknowledge
himselfe as Speciall Bayle for the said John Radish and doth also under
take the payment of the Damages and Cost if it shall happen that the
said pte should obtaine Judgment against the said Deft. in the sd
Decree of Trespasse upon the Case and the said Deft. the Condemnation -
