Secondly the verdict saith that y^e sic hundred pounds of Tobacco
mentioned was well paid but doth not say what Tobacco nor how
paid &c. which is manifest error with many more in y^e record &c.

Which said reasons being read and argued and mature deliberation
being by the Court thereupon taken do adjudge the same good and
sufficient in law to stay y^e verdict a^d. Therefore it is considered
by the Court here viz. the same day last mentioned that the verdict
of the Jurors a^d be wholly set aside and taken for naught and that
the Just. take nothing by y^e verdict a^d.
