High Sheriff of said County and made returne thereof in those words thereon endorsed as follows viz. Capi Ergo Wm Frisby Sher. All which said Court the same Deft being called came and appeared in proper person and the afd ptt by Thomas Downe his atty prayd that the said Deft. might give speciall Bayse to the afd Deft. which was granted and that he be kept in safe Custody by the Sheriff of said County untill he shall give speciall Bayse &c.

All which said next Court viz. the Fifth day of April Anno Domini one Thousand Seven hundred and fifty came the said ptt. by his afd atty and declare as follows viz. That County of George Hill of Kent County in y<sup>e</sup> Province of Maryland Ship Carpenter alid did summon to answer Nathl. Hyson of y<sup>e</sup> same place March. of a plea that he render to him y<sup>e</sup> full and just Sum of Six pounds two Shillings & Six pence Sterling money which to him he oweth and from him unjustly detaineth AND whereupon the said Nathaniel by Thomas Downe his atty saith that whereas y<sup>e</sup> afd George y<sup>e</sup> fiftenth day of August Anno Domini Seven hundred and thirteen at y<sup>e</sup> Parish of St. Paul in Kent County afd within y<sup>e</sup> Jurisdiction of this Court by his afd Bill obligatory which the said George sealed with his Seale and as his deed delivered here in Court brought y<sup>e</sup> date whereof is y<sup>e</sup> same day & year afd did bind himselfe to pay or cause to be paid unto y<sup>e</sup> afd Nathaniel y<sup>e</sup> full and just Sum of Six pounds two Shillings & Six pence Sterling money when thereunto required yet y<sup>e</sup> afd George altho' often required y<sup>e</sup> afd Six pounds two Shill. and
