to His Majesty at Mary Jones's Mary Jones afo^r being committed into Custody as by the former part of this Court proceedings may appear the said Mary in her proper persons appears ordered by the Court here that she be discharged out of Custody on the Commitment afo^r being delivered of a safe borne child and denyed to prove y^e legitimacy untill she Clarke of the Indit^rments had offered a presentm^t to the Grand Jury on the same and now at this day this Court doth discharge the afo^r Mary from the afo^r Commitment and there being an Inditment against the afo^r Mary It is ordered by this Court that the afo^r Mary be sett to the Barr and being there presentment the Inditment sett on y^e Kent County Maryland p^r the Jury for our Sovereign Lord the King that now is & the Body
