That he take Francis Crawford of Kent County Widow Adm. of all & singular of goods & Chattells rights & Credits which were of James Crawford late of sd County Clerk Deceased at the time of his death who died intestate as his said if she should be found in his Baylwick and her safe keep so that he have her body before her said late

Majesties Justices of the next Court to be held at the Court house in the Town of Chester in said County to answer unto Josiah Wolfe and Thomas Norton of a plea of Trespas upon the Case. And that she have them and there by the said writ etc. All which said next Court viz. the second day of November in the first year of the Reign of his now Majesty George 3. the day of return of said writ came William Frisby Gent. Hugh Sheriff of said County and made return thereof in these words thereon answered as follows viz. Copy Corpus of W. Frisby Sheriff

and the said Francis comes into Court and in her proper person appears to the above Jurors and pray liberty thereof to implead herself and to answer att next Court which is granted the same day is given the ptt. in like manner etc.

Att which said next Court viz. the eightth day of April Anno 1744 Domin One Thousand Seven hundred and fifteen came the said ptt. by his atty and put in Security that if the ptt. should be cast in the said Action that the Cost might be satisfied in the County. after which Thomas Bourne comes into Court and saith that he will pay the Cost all his Cost that she shall be putt to in defending herself in the said Action if the ptt. should be
