 To the Sheriff of Kent County greeting we command
 you that if attached any of goods Chattels Rights & Credits of
 Solomon Wild late of said County Plaintiff if they shall
 be found in your Baywick to of value of one Thousand and Eighty pounds of the
 value of the same be attached or any part thereof the same in your
 custody keep so that if have the same before the Justice of our said
 County Court to be held at our Court House in the Town of Christ Church in said County
 on the first Tuesday in June next to satisfie unto Philip Holadger as well by
 Sum of five hundred pounds of Tobacco Damages here Judgment obtained
 against the said Debt before the Justice of our said Court on the third
 day of March Just past whereas he was Convict as appears upon Record
 of Sum of Two hundred & Twenty pounds of Tobacco Cost of Suits as well
 together with the additional Cost thereon during and that by good & lawful
 men of your Baywick if make known unto of party or parties in whose
 hands if makes the same Attachment as if that he or they be or
 appear before the Justice of our said Court at the time & place aforesaid to show
 Cause (if any) why the same ought not to be Executed in his Honor or their
 hands for Satisfaction of the Damages & Cost aforesaid if fail not at your
 peril & have if thought these the names of the persons before whom of
 shall make the same known to this Court
 Justice of our said Court this fifth day of March in the twelfth year of
 His Majesty's Annoque Domini 1713 Rowland Quod Clerk of the
 All which said writ sent by the first day of June Annoque Domini 1713
 Thousand Seven hundred & fourteen the day of return of said writ came
 James Harris Gentleman and made Return thereof in these words there was
 Indorsed as follows These are to Certifie to the Justice within mentioned that
 I have attached of goods and Chattels of within named Solomon Wild
 to of value of one Thousand and Seven pounds of Tobacco that is to say in the
 hands and possession of within named Philip Holadger one two pice Sixty
 Pounds of Tobacco also in of possession of the same one three year old Slave
 whose price five hundred pounds of Tobacco also in of possession of a certain
 Joyner
