Mr William Blay. takes his place and sits on the bench  
Deborah Brown Comes into Court and takes her Corporall  
oath on the holy Evangelists of Almighty God and saith that  
she did see John Gibbs Squire Seal and deliver a power of  
attorney to Nicholas Clouds of Queen Anns County to acknowledge  
a Conveyance of one hundred and fifty Acres of Land part of  
a tract of Land called Tibbs Choyce to Genatus Smith of  
Queen Anns County

John Conolly likewise Comes into Court and takes his  
Corporall Oath on the holy Evangelists of Almighty God and saith  
that he did see the said John Gibbs Squire Seal and deliver  
a power of Attorney to Nicholas Clouds as aforesaid to acknowledge  
a Conveyance of one hundred and fifty Acres of Land as above  
to the said Genatus Smith

Nicholas Clouds as aforesaid being authorized by a power of Attorney  
aforesaid mentioned which is Comprised in a Conveyance for one  
hundred and fifty Acres of Land part of a tract of Land called Tibbs  
Choyce from John Gibbs to Genatus Smith of Queen Anns County  
And now the same Nicholas Comes into Court and acknowledges  
the Conveyance aforesaid to the said Genatus Smith
