untill the then next Court in Course

At which said next Court viz the twenty first day of August the same
year last mentioned y^e same cause was continued untill the then next Court in Course

At which said next Court viz the twenty fourth day of November y^e
same year last mentioned came the said p^lt by his s^d atty and the s^d
Deft being solemnly called came not neither by himselfe nor atty but
made default whereby the said p^lt may remaine against the said Deft
wholly undefended - Therefore it is considered by the Court here viz
this twenty fourth day of November Anno Domini one thousand seven
hundred and sixteen that the s^d p^lt Cornelius Harrington recover against
the said Deft William Jones or w^oll the s^d sume of one thousand and
eight and thirty pounds of Tobacco Debt as also the sume of three
hundred and nine pounds of Tobacco &c. by the s^d p^lt about his Suite
in this behalf expended and by the Court take of his s^d ap^ort adjudged and
the said Deft to be taken into Custody
