 the said County to Answer unto Moray Green of a plea that he render to her the
 full and just sum of Eleven pounds two Shillings and four pence Current money of
 this Province which to her he owes and from her unjustly detains &c. And that he has
 then and there the said writ &c. All which said next Court by this month
 day of June Anno Domini one Thousand Seven hundred and Sixty the
 day of return of said writ came William Frisby Gent High Sheriff of said
 County and made return thereof in these words: Moray Green ordered as follows
 by Capi Copus of W^m Frisby Gent Clerk now at this Court came, the said
 Thomas Bowne his atty and prays that he may put in Security that
 the Debt afo^r shall appear and plead and Non Suite the 1st in the au-
 tion on which Thomas Bowne afo^r comes into Court and acknowledges
 that he will pay the Debt all Est in the auion afo^r if the afo^r shall
 be non suited and the 1st shall not pay the Est. and the afo^r 1st by
 afo^r atty prays that the Debt afo^r may give special Bayse to the above
 auion which is granted after which Honorable Blackiston of said County
 in Court came and acknowledged himselfe special Bayse for the
 Debt and doth undertake the payment of the Debt afo^r and Est there
 on accruing if it should happen that the said 1st shall obtaine Judgment
 against the said Debt in the said auion of Debt and the said Debt
 the Condemnation afo^r shall not satisfy nor himselfe to the Custody of
 the Sheriff of said County deliver or that the afo^r Honorable the body of
 the said Jonas shall not render &c. and the afo^r Debt in his
 proper person appears to the above auion and pray liberty thereof to
 impare thereto and to Answer at next Court which was granted the
 same day is given the 1st also.
