thereof expressing the true cause of action &c. at the last  
place of abode of said Deft according to an Act of Assembly  
of this Province in such Cases made. was as follows Viz. Henry Lowe  
Junior ag. Abraham Bush: Trespas upon the Case The true  
cause of action is the said Deft Abraham Bush stands indebted  
or Ballance to the asst<sup>t</sup> Henry Lowe Jun. the sum of some  
pound fifteen Shillings and eight pence half penny Current money  
of America as p<sup>t</sup> Acco. hereto Annexed appears for which the Deft  
prays an Attachment may to him be granted according to
