proper person to the same recognizance & prays the same
may be discharged as also his Surety's recognizance for his appearance &c.
ordered by the Court here that the same be discharged
John Underhill Junior app^l this recognizance being taken in the sume of
twenty pounds Sterling for his appearance to this Court & to answer what
should be objected against him on his said Lord Ships behalf and in the
mean time he was to be of good behaviour &c. and no person shewing
any cause why the same should not be discharged this Court here discharges
the same
app^l John Underhill Jun^r at the same time as app^l entered into recognizance
for the app^l of the app^l John Underhill Jun^r in the sume app^l to answer as app^l
& to be of good behaviour as app^l. this Court here discharges the same
The app^l John Underhill Jun^r being charged with committing fornication
with a certain Elizabeth Coulson as in the Record of the proceedings app^l
the app^l Elizabeth Coulson may appear &c. And now at this Court the app^l John in his
proper person appears to the same and submits to the Court and Saith
that he cannot gainsay but that he did commit fornication with
the app^l Elizabeth Coulson and that he might be the person that begot the
witt child. Therefore it is considered by the Court here viz this
nineteenth day of June Anno Dom^o 1716 That the app^l John Underhill
Junior be taken to the whipping post and receive on his bare back fifteen
lashes with the Rodd appare for committing fornication as app^l and also pay
the sume of three hundred & fiftie pounds of Tobacco Cost arising on the
premisses app^l.
