 ap^t by Thomas Borne his atty and prayd condemnation of the
 afo five hundred pounds of Tobacco attached in the hands of the
 afo John Berry on the Credits of the above^d Daniel Maggs and
 proclamation being made for the afo John to come in and app^r
 to the same to shew cause if any he hath why the afo five hundred
 pounds of Tobacco should not be condemned to the use of the said p^t
 and no person coming into Court to shew why the same should not
 be condemned as afo: Therefore it is considered by the Court
 here viz this Twentieth second day of March Anno Domini one
 Thousand Seven hundred and fifteen that the afo five hundred
 pounds of Tobacco on the Rights and Credits of the afo Daniel Maggs
 be condemned to the use of the ap^t Thomas Kelley and that
