 Owen had Notice Nevertheless the said James his promise and  
 assumption afo hath not minded nor kept but altho the said James  
 hath made the said one Tunn of Tobacco hogheads in part of  
 the afo promise yet the said James his promise and assumption  
 afo as to the said twelve hundred pounds of Tobacco little regarding  
 but fraudulently intending the said Owen in that behalf to  
 deceive and defraud the said twelve hundred pounds of Tob
