By Thomas Boone his attorney Complainis for that whereas a certain Thomas Cooke the Sixteenth day of March Anno Domini Seventeen hundred and fourteen at St. Pauls parish in Kent County and within of Jurisdiction of this Court stood indebted unto the said Cornelius in the sum of Eleven hundred and Twenty five pounds of Tobacco for the value of the said Cornelius had and received and the said Thomas Cooke for the payment of the said Eleven hundred & Twenty five pounds of Tobacco then and there by a certain Bill or note bearing date the 16th day of March Anno Domini Seventeen hundred & fourteen and with the proper hand of the said Thomas Cooke subscribed to the said Laughlin directed requiring him the said Laughlin to pay unto the said Cornelius or ord. on demand the said Eleven hundred and twenty five pounds of Tobacco and place the same to the credit of the said Thomas Cooke And whereas also the said Cornelius afterwards that is to say the 16th day of March in the year 1716 at the parish in Kent County and within the Jurisdiction of this Court the said Bill or note to the said Laughlin did show and required the same Laughlin to accept and pay the same Eleven hundred and Twenty five pounds of Tobacco in the said Bill or note specified according to the Contents thereof whereupon the said Laughlin the same Bill or note and there last said accept and the same with his proper name by his hand in writing subscribed and the same Laughlin in consideration of the promises afterwards by the said Sixteenth day of March Anno Domini 1716 in the parish and at Kent County and within of Jurisdiction and upon himself assumed to the said Cornelius then and there last said faithfully promised that he the said Laughlin the said Eleven hundred and twenty five pounds of Tobacco unto the said Cornelius when he should demand would well truly pay & Content yet of the said Laughlin his promise
