Quon and that his plea be put in by the Twenty second day of March last mentioned otherwise Judgment to be rendered for want of the same and now at this Court on the day last mentioned the said Deft having put in no plea to the ass. Quon and neither made any answer thereto. Therefore it is considered by the Court here by the same day last mentioned that the ass. plt. Matthias Van Decker do recover against the said Deft Daniel Dumahoo as well the sum of three pounds fifteen shillings & two pence Current money Damages on account of the said Deft his not performing his promises and assumptions as and also the sum of Two hundred fifty six pounds of Tobacco Cost of the ass. plt about his Suite in this behalf laid out and expended and by the Court here of his assent adjudged and the said Deft to be taken into Custody.

Commanded it was to the Sheriff of Kent County the Twentieth day of June in the second year of the Dominion of his now Lord Ship that he take Philip Elbeck of Kent County Glarier if he should be found in his Daily work and him safe keep so that he have his body before his Lord Ship's Justice of the next Court to be held at our Court house in the Town of Chester in said County to answer unto James Crook of a plea of Trespass on the Case and that he have then and there the said writ &c. At which said next Court viz. the twenty first day of August the same year last mentioned the day of return of said writ came William Frisby Gent High Sheriff of said County and made return thereof in these words. Thereon endorsed as follows. Capi Corpus v. Willm Frisby Sheriff. At which said Court the same day last mentioned came the ass. Deft and the said plt by James Crook his atty and prayed that the said Deft might give Spe. Plea to the ass. Quon which was granted and that he be kept in safe Custody by William Frisby Gent High Sheriff of said County
