At which said Court viz y^e twentieth day of November Anno Domini Seventeen hundred and sixteen came the said ptt by his afo^r attorney and the said Deft being called came and the said ptt by his afo^r attorney prays that the said Deft may give Special baile to the above Action which was granted and that William Inggeld Gent one of the Coroners of said County keep the said George Hill in safe Custody untill he shall give Special baile to the above Action At which said Court viz the nineteenth day of March of same year last mentioned came the afo^r Coroner and delivered y^e baile price as folo^w viz
