Court the same Deft being called came and the same p^o by
James Earle his atty prayd that the said Deft might give

Special Baile to the said Deft which was granted and that
William Frisby Sheriff of said County keep the said Deft in
safe custody until he gave Special Baile to the said Deft

Att which said next Court viz the twentieth day of November the
same year last mentioned the said cause was continued until
the then next Court in Course

Att which said next Court viz the nineteenth day of March
the same year last mentioned came the apptd by his atty and
declares as fold viz Maryland Kent County's Philip Elbeck of Kent
County Glazier was attached to answer unto Amos Garrett of a plea
of Trespas ony Case &c And whereupon the same Amos Garrett
by James Earle his attorney Complaind for that whereas the apptd Philip
Elbeck the twenty ninth day of December in the Year of our Lord Christ
one thousand seven hundred and fourteen at S. Pauls Parish in Kent
County ap and within the Jurisdiction of this Court in Consideration the
ap Amos at the Special Instance and request of the ap Philip had

then & there sold and delivered sundry wares and Merchandises to
him the said Philip to the said Philip use as by a particular Bill
thereof ready to be produced in Court may appear upon himselfe as uninc
and
