and to the said Amos then and there faithfully promised that he the said Philip should so much current money of Maryland as the Goods wares & Merchandises as sold & delivered as at the time of the Sale & delivery thereof at reasonable rates and values were worth and amounted unto the said Amos when thereunto afterwards required would well and truly pay and Content and if the said Amos in deed saith that the said goods wares & Merchandises as sold and delivered as at the time of the Sale & delivery thereof at reasonable rates and values were worth and amounted unto the Sum of four pounds fourteen Shillings and four pence current money of the said Province of Maryland as in the Account set forth of which the said Philip had then and there notice and that whereas also the said Philip afterwards viz^y twenty ninth day of December in the year one Thousand Seven hundred & fourteen as at St Pauls Parish in Kent County as & within the Jurisdiction as in Consideration of the said Amos had then and there last said at the special Instance & request of the said Philip sold & delivered to the said Philip an use of divers wares and Merchandises in an acc^t ready to be produced here in Court at the rates & values in the said Account mentioned amounting in y^e whole to the Sum of four pounds fourteen Shillings & four pence Curr. money of y^e said Province upon himself assumed and to the said Amos then and there faithfully promised that he the said Philip the said Sum of four pounds fourteen Shillings & four pence current money as when thereunto required would well and truly Content & pay which as several Sums of current money as in y^e whole amount unto the Sum of nine pounds eight Shillings & eight pence current money as and altho the said Philip afterwards at St Pauls parish in Kent County & within the Jurisdiction as to wit the first day of January Anno Domini one Thousand Seven hundred and fourteen as paid and Satisfied the said Amos the Sum of three pounds & eight pence current money as part of the said nine pounds eight Shillings & eight pence current money as yet the said Philip his promise & assumption as to the Sum of six pounds eight Shillings current money of the said Province residue little regarding but altogether minding and fraudulently intending him the said Amos in this part Craftily & Subtly to deceive & defraud the said six pounds eight Shillings current money as to the said Amos altho afterwards to wit y^e fifth day of January Anno Domini one Thousand Seven hundred & fourteen as at St Pauls parish in Kent County and within the Jurisdiction as and divers other days & times as well before as since he the said Philip was thereto required hath not paid nor made Content therefore but that to pay or Content the said Philip hitherto hath denied & yet deny to the damage of the said Amos
