 sume of Eighteen hundred and fifteen pounds of Tobacco Damages
 as also the sume of four hundred and one pound of Tobacco Cost by the
 app^t about his suite in this behalfe expended and by the Court lib^{er} of
 his apent adjudged and that the said Deft be taken into Custody
