the Suite of a certain George Hill in a plea of Trespass upon the Case then  
in the said Court before the said Justices depending then the said William Glanville  
did undertake the payment of the damages in the action aforesaid and Costs  
arising if it should happen that the said John Hodges should obtain Judgment  
against the said Deft in the said Action of Trespass upon the Case and  
the said Deft the Exemption aforesaid should not satisfy nor himself  
to the Custody of the Sheriff of said County deliver or that the said  
William Glanville the body of the said John Hodges shall not render  
L. which certain action the said William Glanville of his Lands and  
Chattells to be made and to if he should and use of the said George Hill  
to be levied if the said John Hodges in any of premises to make  
default and thereof in Lawfull manner to be convicted as by the  
Record and process thereof in the said Court of the said Lord Proprietor  
here residing manifestly appeareth and altho' the said George Hill aforesaid  
by or on the twenty first day of August last in Court in the second  
year of the Dominion of our Lord Proprietor in the said County Court  
before the said Justices Mr James Harris and his associates then Justices of  
the said Lord Proprietor of the Court and County aforesaid and upon the plea aforesaid  
had recovered against the said John Hodges as well the said sum of six  
pounds twelve Shillings Current money aforesaid Damages as also the sum  
of eleven hundred and twenty nine pounds of Tobacco which to  
the said George Hill in the said Court here were adjudged for his Cost  
which he had by occasion of detaining of his Damages whereof he  
is Convicted sustained as by the Record & process thereof in the said  
Court of the said Lord Proprietor before the said Justices here likewise  
residing doth manifestly appear yet the said John Hodges his body to the  
Custody of the Sheriff of said County did not deliver nor to the said George  
Hill the Damages and Costs aforesaid satisfied as by the Information of the  
said George Hill we receive i.e. the Lord Proprietor received and  
we being willing that those things that in our aforesaid Court before our  
aforesaid Justices / Et quia volumus ea quo in pout Cur ura coram Justis  
nris pout rite ad & recognit sunt debet executioni demandari are  
rightly cited & recognized We Command you that by good & Lawfull  
men of your Party with you make known to the said William Glanville  
that he be and appear before the Justices of our next County Court to be  
held at our Court house in the Town of Chester in said County on the third  
Wednesday in March next to shew cause if any he have or know to say  
wherefore the said George Hill wherefore the said six pounds twelve  
Shillings Current money Damages and eleven hundred and twenty  
nine pounds of Tobacco Cost paid by him in forme aforesaid required
