All which said Court by the nineteenth day of March the same year last mentioned the day of return of said writt came William Frisby Gent high Sheriff of said County and made return thereof in these words thereon endorsed as folo by Copi Corpus & Wm Frisby Sr. But a Deed being filed when said writt issued forth and a Copy thereof served therewith according to Act of assembly in such case made was as folo by Gent County Maryland Joseph Milby of Kent County planter and Did Joseph Milby of Kent County planter was summoned to answer unto Hans Station of plea that he render to him the full and just sume of Eight Thousand three hundred Seventy two pounds of good Sound Merchantable Leaf Tobacco & Cash of value of thirty four pounds Seventeen Shillings and Eight pence Sterling money. he unjustly detaineth &c. And whereas the app ptt by Thomas Doone his atty saith that whereas the app Deft the nineteenth day of November Anno Domini 1775 Seventeen hundred and fifteen at St. Pauls parish in Kent County app within the Jurisdiction of this Court by his atty writing obligatory which the said Deft sealed with his Seal and as his deed delivered here into Court brought the date whereof is the same day year app granted himselfe holden and firmly bound unto the app ptt in the app full and just sume of Eight Thousand three hundred Seventy two pounds of good Sound Merchantable Leaf Tobacco & Cash of value of thirty four pounds Seventeen Shillings and Eight pence Sterling money to be paid the same ptt when thereunto required yet the app Deft altho often required the app Eight Thousand three hundred Seventy two pounds of Tobacco to the said ptt hath not rendered but the same hitherto to render hath denied. yet doth deny and unjustly detain to the damage of the said ptt Four pounds Sterling money and thereupon he brings suite. vs. Thomas Doone ptt John Doone & Richard Doone

All which said Court the app Deft being called upon and the said ptt by his atty app prayd the said Deft might give special bail to the above Union which was granted and that he be kept in safe custody by the Sheriff of said County untill he shall give special bail to the app Union after which Com into Court Arthur Miller of said County and acknowledged himselfe as special bail
