Thomas Winn Jun<sup>r</sup> ap<sup>r</sup> his Recognizance ap<sup>r</sup> taken the tenth day of Aprill last in the sum of five pounds Ster<sup>l</sup> for his app<sup>r</sup> to this Court and keep the peace in the mean time and especially to Arthur Foreman of this County and at this Court no person shewing any Cause why the same recognizance should not be discharged This Court here discharges the same
