 as appears upon Record as also the sume of Six hundred forty four
 pounds of Tobacco and of Suite as also together with the sume of forty six
 pounds of Tobacco and Est hereof fail not at your perill and have
 you then and there this writ Wth Res^{pe} Nathaniel Hynson Gent
 cheife Justice of our said Court this 23rd day of March in the second
 year of our Dominion &c. Anno Domini 1716
