 why the Same goods and Chattells rights or Credits so attached in his  
 her or there hands ought not to be condemned according to Law if to  
 him her or them it shall seem meet and how you shall execute  
 this writ that you make known unto our said Justices at the day and

 By virtue of y<sup>e</sup> within writ to me directed I Certifie to y<sup>e</sup> Justices  
 within mentioned that I have attached one Gelding Colour Roan  
 of the price of six hundred and fifty pounds of Tobacco of the goods  
 and Chattells of the within named Abraham Bush in the hands  
 of a certain Samuel Wallis of aforesaid County Gent and have the Same  
 ready to be condemned to y<sup>e</sup> use of the within named Henry Lowe  
 and I have also made known unto y<sup>e</sup> said Samuel Wallis before  
 Michael Hacker and John good and Lawfull men of my  
 Bailwick that the said Samuel Wallis be and appear at the  
 time and place within mentioned to shew cause w<sup>th</sup> the  
 within writ deateth &c. W<sup>th</sup> Frisby Sheriff

AND now at the said Court came the aforesaid by his aforesaid atty  
 and prayd condemnation of the aforesaid Horse attached in the hands  
 of the aforesaid Samuel Wallis as the goods and Chattells of the aforesaid  
 Debt to the value of six hundred and fifty pounds of Tobacco  
 and the aforesaid Samuel Wallis being solemnly called to shew cause
