The said Samuel Wallis made default and did not appear to the afd Attachment neither by himselfe or an atty. Therefore it is Considered by the Court here by this twentieth day of June Anno Domini one Thousand Seven hundred and Seventeen That the afd Horse attached in the hands of the afd Samuel Wallis as the goods and Chattell of the afd Deft to the value of six hundred and fifty pounds of Tobacco be Condemned to the use of the afd ptt and that he have there of Execution the said ptt giving Security that if in case the same Deft should come in and appear to the original Plecon either by himselfe or his atty and make it appear that the Demand afd is satisfied or any part thereof that then the said ptt shall make restitution of the afd Horse so attached or the value thereof
