Justices of the next Court to be held at our Court in the Town of

the said writ **Att** which said next Court viz the eighteenth day
of June Anno Domini One Thousand Seven hundred and Seven-
teen the day of return of said writ came William Frisby Gent High
Sheriff of said County and made return thereof in these words **Theron**
endorsed as fold viz **Copi Corpus** & **Wm Frisby Sher** - and a
Declaration being filed in said Court declaring the Cause of Action
it being for the sume of Twenty one pounds Eleven Shillings
and one penny - and the said Deft being called came and the **ap**
ptt by Thomas Boone his atty prays the said Deft may give
Special baile to the **ap** Avon which is granted and that the said Deft
be kept in safe Custody by the Sheriff of said County untill he shall
give Special baile to the same Avon

After which Saughlin Filmi of said County here in Court **Comes**
and acknowledeth himselfe Special baile in the **ap** Avon and doth
undertake the payment of the Damages **ap** and Cost accruing if in case
the **ap** **ptt** shall obtaine Judgment in the said Avon of Trespass on
the Case and the said Deft the Condemnation shall not satisfy nor
himselfe to the Custody of the Sheriff of said County deliver or that the
ap Saughlin Filmi the body of the said Deft shall not render **de**
and the **ap** Deft by John Johnson his atty comes and defends the
force and Injury and Saving to himselfe in all manner of advantage
and reception as well to the writ **ap** as to the Declaration of the said
ptt prays liberty to imparle thereto and to Answer at next Court
which is granted the same day is given the **ptt** in like manner
