in the province of Curagoon the first day of April in the
 year of our Lord one Thousand Seven hundred & Fifteen at the parish
 of St Pauls in Queen Annes County and (that is to say) at the parish of St
 Pauls in Kent County and within the Jurisdiction of this Court stood
 justly indebted to the Said John in the said Sum of two Thousand lbs
 of Tobacco of the value of Sixteen pounds Sterling due to the Said John
 for attorney fees as by the said Decree hereunto annexed may more particu-
 larly appear and that he the Said Thomas the Said first day of April
 in the year of after the publication of the said Decree being an inhabi-
 tant of the Said County of Kent in this province did transport or convey
 or cause to be transported or conveyed from the Said County of Kent &
 within the Jurisdiction of this Court by water the said Oliver being a
 freeman to the place commonly called or known by the name of Bohemia
 Landing in Bohemia River at the head of the Bay of Chesapeake
 over & beyond the North Side of Sarafas or Susquehanna Rivers he
 the said Oliver at the same time of such his Conveyance as and not
 having any such pass or passes signed by the Governour keeper of
 the Seal or Secretary of the said Province of Maryland and the same
 Oliver not having under the hand or hands of any Justice of the peace
 (sealed as and) of the Said County of Queen Annes or the Said County of
 Kent where of said Oliver did dwell as in and by the said Decree is
 required and the Said John in fact further says that the said Oliver
 hitherto hath not any wise satisfied contented or paid him the Said
 John the said Sum or quantity of two Thousand pounds of Tobacco or
 any part and that the Said Thomas who transported the same Oliver
 to Bohemia Landing as and did not within one month after such the
 said Oliver's transportation to Bohemia as and procure or cause the
 said Oliver to return or be brought back to Kent County and whereby
 the said Oliver might be liable to the prosecution of such Suits and should
 be commenced or brought against him as by the said Decree still inferre
 the said Thomas is enjoined and required by which action award
 ed to the said John to have and require of the said Thomas the said
 Sum or quantity of two Thousand pounds of Tobacco never the less the
 said Thomas altho often required the said Sum or quantity of two
 Thousand pounds of Tobacco to the said John hath not rendered but to
 the said John hitherto to render hath altogether gainways & still dety-
 gainway to the damage of the said John Ten pimes Sterling and thereupon
 he brings Suite vs. Thomas & plt. pledg. In Doe Rulid Rec.
