Thomas Harry Son to Mary Harry Bound in Court by Consent of the ap<sup>ts</sup> Mary to Evan Evans & his wife Sarah untill he arrives to the age of twenty one yeares and if the ap<sup>ts</sup> Evan and his now wife should die before the ap<sup>ts</sup> Thomas arrives at age as ap<sup>ts</sup> then the ap<sup>ts</sup> Thomas to be at the care of the ap<sup>ts</sup> Mary without any charge &c. and the said Evan doth oblige himself to learn the ap<sup>ts</sup> Thomas to read write & Cypher as far as the rule of three (the said last rule to be inclusive) and to do such work as the Master can do (the said apprentice is four years old the tenth day of Decemb<sup>r</sup> next) the same Indenture acknowledged in open Court

His Majesty Edward entered into Recognizance for Edward Williams at last Novemb<sup>r</sup> Court for his appearance to the next Court in course and at the then next Court he was in March last.
