Recognizance ^{with sureties} for his appearance to next Court and good Behaviour
to all his Lordship's good people and especially to Col Nathaniel Hynson
and his family

Cornelius Doe comes into Court and acknowledges himselfe indebted to
his Lordship his heirs and Successors in the Summe of Twenty pounds
Sterling to be Levied on his goods and Chattels Lands and Tenements.
