Then and there the said will &c. Att which said next Court day the
 nineteenth day of November the same year last mentioned the day
 of return of said will came Simon Wilmer Gent high Sheriff of said County
 and made return thereof in these words wherein endorsed as said day —
 Esq: Ex parte pro Willmer Thos.

After a declaration being filed when said will was produced and a copy
 thereof served herewith according to Act of Assembly in such case made
 was a sum of £100 Thomas Jone of Kent County Planter alld die Thomas Jone
 of Kent County in the province of Maryland was summoned to answer John
 March of a plea that he render unto the plaintiff just sum and quantity of
 eleven hundred and forty pounds of good sound Merchantable Tobacco —
 clear of all manner of trash and ground leaves and Cash to contain the
 same of the price and value of six pounds Sterling money w^{ch} from
 sum sue unjustly demands &c And whereupon the aforesd by Thomas —
 Roome his attorney saith that whereas the aforesd debt the tenth day of December
 in the year of our Lord Christ one thousand seven hundred and thirtynine
 at St Pauls parish in Kent County aforesaid within the jurisdiction of this Court
 by his certain writing obligatorily which he the said debt sealed with his
 Seal and as his deed delivered hereinto Court brought the date whereof is
 the same day and year aforesd granted himself his friends Executors and
 Administrators holden and firmly bound to the aforesd in the aforesd
 just sum and quantity of eleven hundred and forty pounds of good sound —
 Merchantable Tobacco clear of all manner of trash and ground leaves —
 and cash to contain the same of the aforesd price and value of six pounds Sterling
 to be paid to the said pltt after the tenth day of October next ensuing the date
 of said Bill when thereunto required by the aforesd debt altho afterwards by
 the second day of Feby and often after in the year of our Lord Christ one
 thousand seven hundred and sixteen he the said debt was at the parish
 aforesd in the County and jurisdiction by the said pltt thereto required the aforesd
 eleven hundred and forty pounds of Tob. to the said pltt hath not paid
 nor made Content for the same but that to pay or Content the aforesd debt
 hath hitherto denied and yet denies and unjustly demands to the damage of
 the said pltt twelve pounds Sterling money and thereupon he brings suit vs
 for sum of Due pds. £110 Decd R. Roome

And the said debt being called came and the said pltt by his aforesd
 attorney prayd that the said debt might give speciall baile to the aforesd —
 action which was granted and that he be kept in safe custody by the
 Sheriff of said County until he shall give speciall baile to the action
 after which Robert Dunn of B County Sheriff came and
