Baile to the appⁿ Quon which was granted and that he be kept in safe custody by the Sheriff of said County until he shall give special baile to the appⁿ Quon

after which Ebenezer Blackiston of said County here in Court came and acknowledged himselfe as special Baile in the appⁿ Quon and doth undertake the payment of the Damages off and cost thereon accruing if in Case the appⁿ p^t shall obtaine Judgment against the said Deft in the said Quon of Trespas of the Case and the said Deft the Exoneration shall not satisfy nor himselfe to the Custody of the Sheriff of said County deliver or that the appⁿ Ebenezer Blackiston the body of the appⁿ John Bully shall not render &c

and the appⁿ Deft by John Johnson his atty appeared to the appⁿ Quon afterwards the same Quon was continued until the then next Court

John Evans Comanded it was to the Sheriff of Kent County the twenty second day of August in the second Year of his Lordships Dominion &c That he take Robert Ray late of Kent County Mariner if he should be found in the Bayliwick and him

safe keep so that he have his body before his said Lordships Justices of the next Court to be held at our Court House in the Town of Chester in said County to answer unto John Evans Gent Gent of plea of Trespas upon y^e Case and that he have then and there the said writ &c

At which said next Court viz the nineteenth day of November the same Year and the day of return of said writ came Simon Wilmer Gent. High Sheriff of said County and made return thereof in these words thereon endorsed as follo viz Non est inventus y^e Simon Wilmer Sheriff. And a short note being filed when said writ was forth and a copy thereof ~~was~~ therewith according to Act of Assembly to be kept &c which followeth viz

In Evans The true cause of Action which the p^t hath ag^t Rob^t Ray y^e Deft is for that the said Deft y^e Seventh day of March Anno Domⁱ one Thousand seven hundred & fifteen at Chester New Town in Kent County of and within the Jurisdiction of this Court seized of the appⁿ p^t two hind of ~~wool~~ weighing near one Thousand ninety & two pounds of ~~wool~~ of the value of sixteen pounds Sterling money which sum of money of the appⁿ Deft Justly owes and is indebted to said p^t
