that whereas the said Debt the Eleventh day of November in the Year of our Lord Christ one Thousand Seven hundred and Thirteen at St Pauls Parish in the County of Middlesex and within the Jurisdiction of this Court by his certain Bill obligatory which he the said Debt Sealed with his Seale and as his deed delivered hereto Court brought the date whereof is the same day and Year as bound himselfe his Executors or Administrators to pay or cause to be paid to the said p<sup>t</sup> the said full and just Summe of five hundred pounds of Tobacco of the said price and value of four pounds Sterling money Convention upon Chester River in the said County at or upon the tenth day of November next insuing the date of the said Bill obligatory yett the said Debt altho often required the said Summe of five hundred pounds of Tobacco to the said p<sup>t</sup> hath not paid but that he to him to render or pay or cause to be paid the said Debt hitherto hath denied and yett doth deny and unjustly detain to the damage of the said p<sup>t</sup> five pounds Sterling money and thereupon he bringe Suite &c.

and now at the said Court came the said p<sup>t</sup> by his atty as and the said Debt being called came and the said p<sup>t</sup> by his atty prayd that the said Debt may give Special Baile to the said Queen which is granted and that he be kept in safe Custody by the Sheriff of said County untill he shall give Special Baile as a<sup>fo</sup>.

after which John Twegue and Andrew Price both of said County here in Court came and they and either of them doth Acknowledge themselves as Special Baile in the said Queen and they and each of them undertake the payment of the debt as and Cost accruing if in case the said p<sup>t</sup> shall obloynic Judgment against against the said Debt in the said Action of Debt and the Debt the Condemnation as should not satisfy nor himselfe to the Custody of the Sheriff of said County deliver or that the said John Twegue and Andrew Price or either of them the body of the said Debt shall not render &c. and the said Debt came into Court and in his proper person appeared to the said Queen. And saith that he cannot gainsay the Queen as of him the said p<sup>t</sup> nor but that the bill as is his Act and deed and that he oweth unto the said p<sup>t</sup> the said Summe of five hundred pounds
